Editorial: Strive For The Podium

The 2010 Winter Olympics are over. After a tragic start, the Games were an unqualified success. As the host country, Canada and all Canadians should feel a tremendous sense of pride. The country garnered a record 14 gold medals, capped off by the heroics of our esteemed hockey team.

Overall, Canada finished third, behind the powerful Americans and the eclectic Germans. Our winning crossed many sports: mens' and women's hockey, ice-dancing, men's curling, men's moguls and women's ski cross, skeleton, snowboarding, and speed-skating, long track and short track. In all, Canada won 26 medals. We also had the greatest number of fourth and fifth place finishes.

The Americans, too, can feel proud. They won the most medals, 37 and, with 15 silver, were always in contention for gold in so many disciplines.

Hopefully, with the whole country crystallized behind this magnificent showing, Canada may realize that it has the new-found ability to exert itself to a greater extent on the world's stage. Government should seize the moment, capitalize on our well-deserved respect, and foster and promote Canada and Canadian business in the international arena.

Wallbridge Mining Company Limited (\$0.28 - February 23, 2010; WM-TSX) Wallbridge announced that the wedge-cut WMM-014-WI at the Parkin Offset Property at Sudbury, drilled from the parent hole WMM-014, has intersected two intervals of semi-massive copper-nickel sulphide mineralization within a broader 12.66-metre zone, which assayed 0.96% copper, 0.44% nickel, and 2.85 g/t total precious metals (TPM). The intersect, along with the down-hole UTM surveys completed in the new hole, indicates the presence of conductive sulphide mineralization over an apparent distance of at least 150 metres along strike and 100 metres down dip.

Integrated Asset Management Corp. (\$0.60 - February 23, 2010; IAM-TSX) IAM and its wholly-owned retail alternative investment subsidiary, Blumont Capital Corporation, announced the completion of the acquisition of investment management firm Northern Rivers Capital Management Inc.

Rocmec Mining Inc. (\$0.07 - February 24, 2010; RMI-TSX-V) Rocmec has published information on the Company's Rocmec 1 gold property in Rouyn-Noranda, Quebec. The report is designed to provide an overview of the process involved in developing the world's first thermal gold property. The Company's report covers Rocmec 1, diamond drill campaigns, structures and drill results, and the thermal fragmentation mining method. An updated NI 43-101 compliant resource calculation and scoping study are in preparation.

Marathon PGM Corporation (\$1.09 - February 25, 2010; MAR-TSX-V) Marathon PGM reported high-grade intervals of PGM-Cu mineralization at the Geordie Lake PGM-Cu deposit near Marathon, Ontario. The intersections confirm along strike and up-dip continuity of high-grade mineralization from historical drilling. The first seven holes intersected higher-than-historic average grades of Cu and Ag. The campaign of 21 holes (3,000 metres) is expected to be completed in the first week of March.

Titan Medical Inc. (\$0.37 - February 23, 2010; TMD-TSX-V) Titan Medical has signed a contribution agreement with the National Research Council of Canada - Industrial Research Assistance Program, a federally-funded program supporting the commercialization of innovative Canadian technologies. The financial assistance will support the development program of Titan's robotic arm technology for Amadeus ®, the next generation robotic surgery platform.
